## 1. Data Drive Justice Update

*An update was provided regarding this White House initiative that is being coordinated with NACO and the Arnold Foundation. Our participation should provide our CJC members and their organizations access to learning and research opportunities. It was suggested that the CJC may want to encourage an MOU for data sharing between Human Services, 911 dispatch and law enforcement. Johnson County Kansas is similar in size and may serve as a template for our data project. Reyes and Clark-Bernhardt received a \$35,000 scholarship for data analysis. Reyes then presented a proposed data sharing process with the CJC.*
