Maniaci shared that the YC approved the HS survey last week and is embarking on an initiative to develop teaching lesson plans using DCYA to expand use at classroom level. Hansen noted that the survey is used in curriculum in many outlying districts. Pinske identified plans to increase use/access through MMSD. Maniaci also reported the Commission is exploring a separate URL for the survey. Use of the data will be the Committee's main focus after the survey is administered.

C. Action Items

1. Review the DCYA Middle School Survey draft for content, order and revisions. Recommend it be submitted to the Youth Commission and school districts for review and approval.

Koenig reviewed the overall revisions made to the MS survey. Committee reviewed the content, order and identified the following MS survey revisions:

- i. Add HS "Sources of stress" item (remove "car" language) after Item #36
- ii. Change "Race/Ethnicity" item to exact language used in HS including option to specify ethnicity.
- iii. Use exact four HS survey items on gender
- iv. Item #15, remove three response items "safety, parent permission, comfort in locker room"
 - v. Item 29 & 30—remove from MS
- vi. Remove items 37 from HS
- vii. Item 48 remove "r" from "time"
- viii. Remove skip after #48
- ix. Item 49, remove "Get drunk item"
- x. Item 50, specify "Choose one", use MS question and HS choice items (#77)
- xi. Item 53, change from 12 months to "30 days"; fix typo in first item; use same scale options in all 30 day use AODA questions
- xii. Add two federal AODA questions—risk of harm (HS #89) and peer approval (HS #92)—add to MS
- xiii. #55 change "smoke marijuana" to "use"
- xiv. #56 remove "Get drunk" option
- xv. Remove skips from AODA section
- xvi. #63 add answer option "using put downs"
- xvii. Item 70 add option about "political views/beliefs" and change HS to language from "political affiliation" to "political views/beliefs"
