1. Stormwater Volume Trading Program Work Group - discussion with members of the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission

#### a. Review and refine work group tasks

Terrell led the discussion. The group discussed suggested tasks for the work group, drafted by Balousek. Members agreed to pursue the following tasks:

- 1. Identify the agencies/organizations that would provide oversight and implementation of the volume trading program.
- 2. Develop structure/guidelines for the stormwater volume trading program.
- 3. Identify potential project sites to demonstrate the cost-effectiveness of stormwater volume trading.

#### b. Discuss steps necessary before implementing a stormwater volume trading program

For the next meeting on November 2, the group would like to hear presentations on two topics:

- 1. From municipal representatives of communities with stormwater volume standards that exceed county minimums: how is that working, and what would they change if they could? (Rupier will invite Ken Potter or Gary Huth to talk about Middleton's experience.)
- 2. "Real world" examples of project costs to control 100% of stayon volumes, and what credits in a volume trading system would cost to produce. (Balousek will prepare these.)
