Wescott, Reopelle, and Brockmeyer presented.

Reopelle: primary objective of Office for Climate and Energy is to work with the Climate Council. There is an opportunity to do emissions modeling. The modeler is doing the entire Midwest. Using this vendor will help us with our climate action plan. Second, the BUILD program would be restructured to an energy focus. Funding for planning or audits for energy efficiency. BUILD has \$45K. Discussion ensued.

Todd Violante spoke of the evolution of the BUILD program. Activity with BUILD has waned in recent years. Jurisdictions have expressed interest in implementation money.

Brockmeyer: Spoke of reallocation of County Executive Chief of Staff from M16 to M17.

Sparkman spoke on Office for Equity and Inclusion:

PIE grant will be allocated in December.

Looking into a computer tracking system for businesses.

Looking into whether they can spend \$10 K on Scholars of Promise.
