## Opiate Update

*Lohmeier gave a brief summary of the new clinic ASAP that is opening the week of the 16th. It will have extended hours and plans to not only have medications for addiction but also counseling. The open house information was distributed. Meier discussed the OD map program that is being looked at by Public Health and will involve EMS. This is a federal tracking web based service that is being utilized around the country to map overdose situations. Next step is to look at best practices and have this discussion with the EMS partners. The subcommittee felt there would need to be a projected plan for action based on the data in order to ask EMS to enter more information. We will update the subcommittee next month on progress.*
