G. Reports to Commission

1. Activity Report

Jones was excited to report that from November last year to November, 2019 growth was phenomenal at 31% and year-to-date up 12.8% and is expected to be higher by year end. The Airport is doing way beyond the national average of around 6 - 7% growth.

There are now around 19 Non-Stop destinations both year round and seasonal.

Jensen reported that Military Operations including deployments are up 44%. Many airline diversions come here due to weather.

The commission members asked some specific questions about the future terminal expansion. Jones assured the commission that the staff will provide up-to-date specifics and bring forth any items for approval that the commission will act upon.

2. Air Park Matters

Jones reported on the status of Air Park Tenants and their current up-to-date status on lease payments and interesting building projects moving forward. Discussion ensued and commissioners were pleased with the report.

There was discussion about surveying developers about the potential and feasibility of building a mid-scale hotel on Airport property. Jones assured the commission that she would check with the "North Central" group who had previously studied this (and may again in the future), and other groups and report back the results.

I. Public Comment on Items not on the Agenda

There was no public comment on items not on the agenda.

J. Such Other Business as Allowed by Law

Supervisor RUSK made a request to Chair HAIGHT to comment on two recent items. Chair HAIGHT granted the request.

Rusk reported that at a recent Noise Subcommittee meeting an individual was video taping. The reason the individual was taping was to do a future report on the F-35s. Rusk will grant a requested future interview on the F-35s topic.

The second item Supervisor RUSK wanted to share was that the local newspaper reported that there would be monthly testing on the Perflourinated compounds (PFAS) affected wells.

Jones mentioned that the Guards F-35 Environmental Impact Study is scheduled to be completed by September, 2019.

There were a few questions and answers regarding the recent Government shutdown and that it may slow down the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approval process on various projects.

Jones added that there is a vacancy on the Airport commission for a "representative outside of the City's East side." She knows of at lease two individuals who have expressed interest to the County Executive for appointment.
