1. Approve Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan for Dane County 2019-2023

Discussion on plan - Lyman stated the Madison Area Transportation Planning Board approved the Coordinated Transportation Plan June 19, 2019. He summarized Chapter 4 & Chapter 5 to the plan and updates were based on public comments. (See attached slides for details).

Durocher asked if a driver training feasibility study included changes for criminal history reviews of drivers. There was discussion on some of the issues agencies are having when doing background checks. At this time Driver eligibility criteria is defined by individual contracts and or transportation providers. The Coordinated Plan does not set criteria.

Lyman discussed Section 5310 being two tiered process with an updated scoring system and provided the timeline for application with the deadline. He stated the application release would be 6/21/19 and due date 8/4/19 midnight.
