#### D. Presentations

Kennedy Turner of Blueprint Events summarized the 2019 South Metro Business Walk draft Final Report. In total, 52 business and civic leaders visited 377 businesses in three hours. 69% of businesses stated that business was good/great; 62% of businesses answered "location" when asked what they like about doing business in the area; and 49% of businesses responded that "access" was the challenge they were most concerned with in the 2019-2020 Verona Road and Fish Hatchery Road construction projects.

Of the 377 businesses visited, 77 requested and received follow-up assistance. The Final Report will be available later this month and shared with all businesses that provided contact information.
