Dea Larsen Converse with the Clean Lakes Alliance spoke in support.
Supervisor Chenoweth asked for additional information on the need for the contract amendment and obligations of the vendor under the existing contract. Laura Hicklin and Kyle Minks, staff of the Land \& Water Resources Department, along with vendor representative John Sorenson, addressed Supervisor Chenoweth's questions. Specifically, Hicklin shared that the contract amendment is necessary to remove solids that are leaving the manure digester before they reach the nutrient concentration system. The solids leaving the digester exceed the volumes that were anticipated at the time of system design. The nutrient concentration system is based on an agreed centrate containing $1.5 \%$ total suspended solids or less. Per the contract, the cost for installation of any expanded system to handle manure waste volumes in excess of this assumption will be done at additional expense to the County.

The Committee stated their expectation that no further cost increases would be requested and that the system would be operational in the near future.
