There is a need for services for LGBTQ+ and youth of color, culturally appropriate providers who can speak the same language and not utilize patients as interpreters, space for culturally competent providers to provide service, incorporate criteria for folks utilizing technology which may help override transportation issues, and peer support.

Public Comment:

•Kathy Oriel is a physician specializing in addiction medicine and LGBTQ hormone therapy and also founder of the non-profit Out Health. She feels there is overwhelming mental health and substance use disparities in the LGBTQ community. She would like to see some funds directed to hiring mental health providers to run specific support groups.

2. Recommendations for RFP Policy Criteria

Tessmann provided the attached handout. Committee members gave the following input:

- •24-hour resources for crisis situations
- •Develop culturally relevant outreach and engagement
- •Training for mentoring because people go to faith communities and food pantries and may not go to community centers
- Training and outreach in diverse spaces
- •Additional training for people of color to be in positions like after school programs
- •Long-term supported housing for young men of color especially those with mental health and/or substance abuse issues
