Bill Lunney, President of the Foundation for Dane County Parks and former long standing Chair of the Park Commission, spoke on the resolution. Lunney stated that the Foundation first organized 6 years ago and is totally operated by volunteers. The Foundation has nearly raised \$1,000,000 in that short time. The Foundation has three program areas: 1) Growing the Friends of Dane County Parks Endowment, 2) Special Park Projects (currently Accessible Piers) and 3) the Foundation Operations. The Foundation has received two capacity grants to help grow the organizational functions over a three year period. One of the grants was through the Madison Community Foundation and the other through the Schlecht Foundation. The majority of the money will be used to hire a staff person to help with the daily functions of the Foundation. The position will be the liaison working between Parks staff and the Foundation to grow this exciting public/private partnership supporting the County Parks system and all its Friends groups.
