Lauren Kuhl presented on the plan to engage the public on the question of board size and presented draft questions for submitting to the public. Committee members asked questions and made suggestions regarding changes to the questions (specifically, a few members wanted to pose the question of whether the board should be larger and also to ask respondees for their reasons for wanting a smaller or larger board). The survey will be finalized and translated into Spanish and Hmong and then distributed to the public.

The Executive Committee will further deliberate on the issue of board size after public input is received. The Committee is likely to make a decision on the board size at its August 13th meeting at the earliest.
