Supervisor Dave Ripp provided a brief background of the flooding that has occurred on Crystal and Fish Lakes. He provided information that MSA Engineering studied different options to mitigate flooding. One possible solution that MSA reported on is to construct a pipeline from Fish Lake to the Wisconsin River. This resolution acknowledges the MSA report and will help with moving forward to explore opportunities for funding from the state.
