1. Winter Park Use - Website Information

Marsh and Stinson provided an overview of park use observations. High public use continues in the county parks including filled parking lots and winter activity areas. Marsh stated that there has been strong permit sales with recent snowfalls and lakes freezing over providing safe ice conditions.

2. 2021 COVID Planning for Facilities and Events

Stinson provided an update on Public Health restrictions. Public Health recently increased the maximum size of outdoor gatherings from 25 to 50 participants. Indoor activities remain restricted to 10 people. Parks will be working closely to monitor Public Health regarding outdoor gathering restrictions and keeping our patrons informed.

3. Proposed Riley Deppe Park Transfer

Marsh stated that the pandemic slowed down the transfer of Riley Deppe County Park to the Village of Marshall. The process is now moving forward. The Park Commission will review draft documents and provide input and approvals.

4. 2021 Deconstruction Projects

Marsh provided an update on proposed 2021 winter demolition projects, including two properties along STH 19 and flooded properties at Fish Lake.
