In addition to her written report, Dane County Department of Human Services Director Shawn Tessmann reported staff have reviewed and are in agreement with recommendations by a coalition of state law enforcement agencies, health care professionals, local governments and other stakeholders to improve the handling of emergency mental health detentions.

Tessmann reported Governor Tony Evers' biennial budget bill is expected to include a proposal to accept federal money to expand the Medicaid program, which would provide additional revenue to bolster DCDHS services, and proposals to strengthen early care and education.
