Update on Redistricting Process by Redistricting Commission Staff

Brian Standing, Planning and Development staff for Redistricting Commission, gave an update on the activities of the commission and potential timeline with the caveat that the timeline was likely to change significantly if the US census is delivered late, which is likely.

Supervisors asked clarifying questions regarding the process, e.g., when will community have input and give comment? (there will be several formal hearings); whether it will be sufficient to have a hearing before the commission or also before the county board (full county board hearings required according to Corp Counsel)); who is in charge of drawing municipal ward boundaries? (Municipalities are. Municipal clerks are the point of contact for this).
