- 4. Are there any other sources of CARES funds not included in the application?
- 5. Besides CDBG funding, what else needs to happen before this project is set to beain?
- 6. Describe in detail how any CDBG funds received will be spend.
- 7. Can/will this project move forward if you receive less funding than requested? Any limitations on this?
- 8. Can all funds awarded in 2021 be reasonably expected to be expended? If this is a multi-year project, what amount of funds will be spent in each year?
- 9. Describe the risks to undertaking this project and your plans to address them.
- 10. If the funding request is for an existing program, at what point will the program become self-supporting? If never, what are other sources of funding? What additional money can be leveraged?
