#### 2. Badger Mill Creek Restoration

Rigelman discussed a partnership project with the City of Verona related to Badger Mill Creek and the replacement of outdated sanitary sewer. With the replacement of the outdated sewer it provides the opportunity for the County to improve fish habitat, water quality, and the Ice Age Trail. The County will also work at removing invasive species to improve the riparian area around the stream. The project will take place over the next year. The Ice Age Trail will be updated with a new bridge over the Creek and boardwalk sections through the restored marsh.

#### 3. State Highway 69 Mitigation Proposals

Rigelman discussed the need to explore further mitigation options with WisDOT on County lands along the STH 69. WisDOT staff offered approximately ~\$30,000 in mitigation value associated with lands that WisDOT will require for their STH 69 Improvement Plan. The options include creating a new access at the north end of the Sugar River Wildlife Area – Basco Unit and/or updates to an existing parking lot and river access site at Falk Wells Wildlife Area. Rigelman stated that staff's first choice is the new access at the north end of the Basco Unit.
