# 1. Cambridge Area Senior Resource Network 2020-21 Community Survey: Transportation Results (Jesse Herr, UW-Madison Social Work Graduate Student)

Supervisor Carl Chenoweth introduced Jesse Herr, UW-Madison Social Work graduate student. Jesse presented his Needs Assessment survey which had been disbursed to residents of Cambridge and surrounding townships, 85% in Dane County. Main takeaways included people who utilized resources were very satisfied but many people appear unaware of available community resources. Survey did not appear to include rides through the Dane County Transportation Call Center but results may indicate many eligible seniors in the Cambridge area may be unaware of local senior center resources. Discussion ensued regarding how to engage the community beyond resources located via the senior center.
