ACT-123 REVIEW AND POSSIBLE FINAL RECOMMENDATION ON 2022 ACT-123 FARMLAND PRESERVATION PLAN DRAFT

Brian Standing reviewed the proposed text of Volume I of the 2022 Dane County Farmland Preservation Plan. Volume I includes:

- the planning background;

- goals, objectives and policies for farmland preservation

- a description of the plan development and adoption.

Volume II will include maps, agricultural inventory and appendices. Volume II is still under development and will be added to the ordinance amendment adopting the plan in time for the public hearing before the ZLR committee.

The committee thanked the staff team for their work. Discussion followed regarding applicability of county plan in incorporated villages and cities, and associated budget requests for programs proposed in the plan.

Motion by Lauber, second by Fulwider to make the following amendments to the draft plan:

1. Where appropriate, revise references solely to "towns" to "towns, cities, villages and extraterritorial authorities."

2. Include specific references to "farm-to-table" and "Buy Dane" marketing programs.

Further moved to recommend Volume I of the 2022 Farmland Preservation Plan as amended to the county board for introduction and consideration at public hearing by the Zoning and Land Regulations committee.
