AMENDING THE DANE COUNTY FARMLAND PRESERVATION PLAN

Specific changes to the Farmland Preservation Plan include:

1. Text amendments to allow lands within Urban Service Areas to qualify as Farmland Preservation Areas if they are under an existing, recorded agricultural conservation easement, and;
2. Relatively minor Farmland Preservation Plan map amendments to:
 - reflect the change in policy above;
 - adjust plan district boundaries to better facilitate Farmland Preservation Zoning consistency, as required by s.91.38, Wis. Stats., and;
 - bring the map into consistency with the *Dane County Comprehensive Plan* to reflect amendments resulting from Urban Service Area boundary changes approved by the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission.
