3	ACCEPTANCE OF THE EPCRA PLANNING GRANT FOR FY2025
4	
5	Each year Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) provides the Emergency
6	Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) Planning Grant for funding of
7	eligible expenses that support the completion of Local Emergency Planning Committee
8	(LEPC) administrative requirements, hazmat planning, community preparedness
9	activities, and local exercises in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes §§59.54(8)(a), and
10	323.61, and to complete EPRCRA program requirements as provided by WEM under
11	WEM Directive 2007.2 EPCRA Planning Grant Funding. This grant is given to a county
12	Emergency Management program to assist with maintaining the program and
13	supporting local EPCRA initiatives.
14	
15	Dane County Emergency Management Hazardous Materials Planner meets and
16	exceeds all items related to the EPCRA and LEPC requirements. The award amount for
17	FY2025 is \$100,813.45. The award amount is included in the annual Hazmat division
18 19	budget to offset the expenses related to the programs.
20	THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the
21	Dane County Executive hereby accept \$100,813.45 in EPCRA Planning Grant funds for
22	Wisconsin Emergency Management for FY2025; and
23	Wisconsin Emergency Management for 1 12020, and
24	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Dane County Executive is authorized to sign the
25	grant award agreement, and that the Dane County Emergency Management Director, or
26	their designee, is authorized to submit all required reports and reimbursement requests
27	to Wisconsin Emergency Management.
