Authorization to Continue Contract with and Distribute funds to Selected Applicants from the 2022 Roadmap to Reducing Violence in Madison and Dane County RFP

Public Health-Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) released the 2022 Roadmap to Reducing Violence in Madison and Dane County Request for Proposals to seek applicants interested in receiving funding towards prioritized violence prevention goals, strategies and activities from the Violence Prevention Plan (Roadmap to Reducing Violence). Applicants from this RFP were scored by external panelist and reviewed for recommendation to fund.

PHMDC contracted with these agencies in 2022 to provide funding, and are recommended to continue contract with and fund at the following amounts:
