

**ACCEPTANCE OF US FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE
PARTNERS FOR FISH AND WILDLIFE FUNDS
FOR PRAIRIE AND SAVANNA RESTORATION**

The Land & Water Resources Department has secured a \$20,000 contribution from the US Fish and Wildlife Service Partners for Fish and Wildlife Program to be used to restore and enhance prairies and savannas on Dane County Parkland to benefit federal trust resources such as monarch butterflies, rusty patched bumble bees and other high priority prairie and savanna species of concern. These restorations provide critical habitat for native pollinators, migratory bird species of concern, and provide access and recreational benefits to a large urban population base.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept \$20,000 in funds from the US Fish and Wildlife Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dane County Parks Director and Natural Resource Manager are authorized to execute project reports and reimbursement documents.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account LWRPKOP 80102 US Fish & Wildlife Grant revenue account be increased by \$20,000, LWRPKOP 10079 LTE-Land Management/Restoration be increased by \$18,579 and LWRPKOP 10108 Social Security be increased by \$1,421. These funds shall be carried forward until expended.
