



WRTP BIG STEP PAVING THE WAY

To qualify for union apprenticeships, applicants need the following:

- ✓ Driver's License
- ✓ Social Security Card
- ✓ High school diploma,GED, or HSED
- ✓ Passing AptitudeTest Scores



BIG STEP APPRENTICESHIP READINESS PROGRAM

The BIG STEP Apprenticeship Readiness program provides one-on-one tutoring for participants testing for the building trades.

- 1 hour tutoring sessions
- In-person or online
- Open Monday-Saturday from 8 am-7pm

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OUTREACH & RECRUITMENT

- 4 JustDane Reentry Resource Fairs
- Electrician Union Career Fair
- 16 outreach events, including BIG STEP programming orientations
- Monthly Joint Apprenticeship Council meetings
- Community outreach with re-entry partners

JOINT APPRENTICESHIP COUNCIL MEETINGS

- Monthly meetings with WRTP | BIG STEP contributing trades
- Different topics each meeting, like how to:
 - Streamline the application process
 - Identify barriers with unions or contractors in hiring Pave Your Path grads
 - Best support participants transitioning back into the community from incarceration and into construction Registered Apprenticeships
 - Provide insight into additional skills and credentials needed to enter respective trades
 - How to best set Pave Your Path participants up for





Q1 OUTCOMES

1st Pave Your Path In-Custody group at the Dane County Jail:

- 20 initial participants
- 8 participants withdrew
- 12 completed the eightweek program
- 8 participants passed tests for trade requirements
- 2 participants from the group were released from incarceration in the middle of this program and

JustDane Reentry Service Fairs, referral partners, word of mouth, walk-ins:

- 15 participants
- 100% completed and passed their Accuplacer testing
- In our Entry-Level Construction Skills training, 2 participants enrolled in cohort 1.
 - ✓Both in cohort 1 completed

Q2 OUTCOMES

2nd Pave Your Path In-Custody group at the Dane County Jail:

- 31 initial participants
- 18 participants withdrew or were released
- 13 completed the eightweek program
- 11 participants passed tests for trade requirements


JustDane Reentry Service Fairs, referral partners, word of mouth, walk-ins:

- 20 participants
- 4 took and passed Accuplacer testing
- 5 referred to the Electricians union to begin application and testing process
- In our Entry-Level Construction Skills training, 7 enrolled in cohort 2.
 - √3 successfully completed

STORY OF SUCCESS – Jaton M.

- Participant started with us in the Pave Your Path Program.
- After he was released, he:
 - joined our ELCS training
 - attended our career fair in partnership with Operation Fresh Start
 - attended tutoring and completed his testing requirements
 - and received his letter of introduction with the Plumbers Union.
- During ELCS training, he was placed as a Plumbing Pre-Apprentice with Dave Jones, starting full time at \$18/hour
