The motion carried by a voice vote 6-0.

A motion was made by WEGLEITNER to strike the mention of a AAA Board Secretary in Article V, Section 1 and in Article V, Section 3. The motion carried by a voice vote 6-0.

A motion was made by WURF to amend Article VI, Section 2 by striking "the Access" and inserting "the Advisory Council" in the first sentence, to insert a sentence after the first two that reads "No members of the Advisory Council shall serve on the AAA Board" and to amend Article VI, Section 3 by replacing "Members of the Access" with "Members of the Advisory Council." The motion carried by a voice vote 6-0.

Riley reported the event is scheduled for June 12 at Warner Park in partnership with the City of Madison, the Dane County Department of Waste and Renewables, Adult Protective Services and Pellitteri Waste Systems.

Riley shared that Nellie Brown will begin her duties as AAA's Registered Dietitian & Healthy Aging Coordinator on June 15. Brown has been managing the Goodman Community Center's nutrition program.

Riley thanked AAA Clerk Cindy Matulle for her efforts in the smooth operation of the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program while the Registered Dietitian & Healthy Aging Coordinator position was vacant. Matulle reported that as of today, 574 of the 824 voucher booklets have been distributed to older adults who qualify while applications are still arriving steadily.
