Manure Storage Facility Permits

| Permit | Fee | Notes |
|--|---------|---|
| Manure Storage Facility | \$1,000 | Includes: construction of a new facility, modification of existing facility, transfer systems, leachate/runoff collection systems |
| Manure Storage Facility After the Fact Permit | \$2,000 | Charged if construction occurs without a permit |
| Manure Storage Closure | \$0 | No fees if permit is obtained prior to closure |
| Manure Storage Closure After the Fact Permit | \$1,000 | Charged if closure starts without a permit |
| Certificate of Use | \$1,000 | Application can include multiple facilities under one farm |

Note: Cost-share assistance may be available for construction or closure. A cost-share contract shall be signed before work can commence.

Winter Spreading Permits

| Permit | Fee | Notes |
|---|-------|---|
| Winter Spreading Permit <i>w/SNAP Plus Database</i> | \$0 | Submit an electronic copy of the SNAP Plus database that includes the winter spreading plan |
| Winter Spreading Permit <i>w/out SNAP Plus database</i> | \$100 | Submit a PDF copy of the Nutrient Management Plan that includes the winter spreading plan |
| Winter Spreading Permit <i>w/out Nutrient Management Plan</i> | \$500 | Staff are available to assist with the development of plan for first time permittees |

Note: Cost-share assistance may be available to develop a nutrient management plan. A cost-share contract shall be signed before a plan is developed.

** The department will determine if the submitted application and supporting materials meets the fee waiver eligibility requirements.*
