County Board of Supervisors passed

- i. Operating Amendments:
 - 1. Reduction of 1% for DCDHS POS Agency partners.
 - 2. Increase funding for the men's shelter by \$817,240.
 - 3. Provide \$440,000 for outreach service and men's overflow shelter.
 - 4. Increase the Sun Prairie partnership for TRC services for Eastern Dane County by \$2,000.
 - 5. Provide \$50,000 for overflow shelter hotel vouchers for unhoused families.
- ii. Capital Amendments:
 - 1. \$10 million increase to the Affordable Housing Development Fund, bringing it up to \$20 million in 2026.
 - 2. \$2 million to purchase land for lawful sleeping options for unhoused persons.

2026 contracts were adjusted and sent to agencies for signature.
