WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, to it in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowleaged, has given, granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Dane, State of Wisconsin, to-wit:

The premises commonly known as 23 West Doty Street, Madison, Wisconsin, and more particularly described es the Southwest Half (SW2) of Lot Three (3), and the Northeast Fifty-six (56) Feet of Lot Two (2), Block Eighty-five (85), Original Plat, City of Madison.

This deed includes the bowling alleys and all other fixtures presently a part of the premises.

This deed is given to confirm title, which has already vested in the party of the second part by virtue of condemnation proceedings, and therefore no revenue stamps are required.
