It would be helpful to know how much has been spent and how the allocations have been set up, this conversation could be ahead of the next one we have with Felicia (Opioid Settlement Coordinator), this could be useful to use in the 2027 Recommendation. Spending Rates and how much is projected for 2027 would be good to have this information. SMITH mentioned in the past, we have had recipients give reports to the subcommittee and we could match financial progress and where people are with deliverables; invite the public to provide comment on this item. See if contract holders want to submit a written report or testimony on how they would like to be heard, this gives options to provide additional feedback within a short timeframe.
