

- SNP PILOT PROGRAMS 1972
- SNP PROGRAMS BEGAN IN 1973 1974
- CONGREGATE BEGAN 1ST, THEN HOME DELIVERED MEALS CAME LATER

PURPOSE OF OAA:

- "To improve the quality of life for all older Americans by helping them to remain independent and productive."
- Oversee the development of services and opportunities
- Respect the dignity of individuals
- Remove social barriers
- Provide continuum of care
- Secure opportunities for seniors
- Serves anyone age 60+

PURPOSE:

- To reduce hunger, food insecurity, and malnutrition



WHAT ARE WE DOING TO DEAL WITH THE REDUCED/STAGNANT FUNDING:

- ✓ Developed a new Staff & Volunteer Meal Policy = Cost Savings of \$20,000
 - ✓ Eliminates meals for underage staff
 - ✓ Still includes meals for volunteers of (only) the Senior Nutrition Program any age
 - ✓ Enforces full cost payment for those not eligible for the program.

✓ Increased Suggested Donation Rate

- ✓ Starting October 1, 2025 rate increased from \$4.50 to \$5.00
- ✓ During the last program year Oct 1, 2023 Sept 30, 2024:
 - ✓ Average donation per meal \$2.05
 - ✓ History of increasing donation rate by 50 cents caused an increase of 13 cents/meal,
 - ✓ Using this history, we can estimate an additional minimum of \$32,500

✓ Reducing waste and utilizing catering padding

- ✓ Making every ordered meal count whether clients cancel or no-show give méals to walk-in clients or to those at risk for malnutrition or food insecurity, etc. Freeze meals to have meals at a moments notice for a new client in-need.
 - ✓ PY 2023-2024: Ordered 270,588 meals, but actually served 271,365 meals!

WHAT ARE WE DOING TO DEAL WITH THE REDUCED/STAGNANT FUNDING:

- ✓ <u>Enforcing communication between case management, nutrition, data entry & AAA staff:</u>
 - ✓ Enforce program requirement: annual in-person assessments that detail the client's needs
 - ✓ Assign meals based on prioritization system in place since 2014
 - ✓ Relaxed due to COVID-19
 - ✓ High Risk 5 meals/week
 - ✓ Moderate Risk 3 meals/week
 - ✓ Low Risk 2 meals/week
- ✓ Acquire meal authorizations to provide full price meals to Managed Care Organizations:
 - ✓ Acquire meal authorization with first 2 weeks of joining MCO
 - ✓ Require MCO to back date meal authorization to cover all meals received since start date

WHAT'S NEXT:

- Will need to ask for more funding for Operations in 2026 to maintain current program offerings.
- OAA Reauthorization: Included option to utilize 25% of C1 Funding to use as carryout meals.
 - The State of WI has to include this in their aging plan in order for this to be an option for AAA's.
 - After feedback from WI Nutrition Directors and AAA's, the state is currently drafting the language in their state plan, after they also receive feedback from their state aging advisory counsel this month, to include this as an option. Not 100% yet, but it looks like it will be.
 - Each WI AAA can decide if we want to utilize this option.
 - In Dane County it would be great to have this option to fall back on:
 - <u>In disasters/emergencies.</u> For example: A congregate site floods or is damaged by storms or fire can still use C1 funding to distribute carryout meals even if there's not a place to sit and dine.
 - In locations where there is no current HDM program
 - If we receive funding, greater than our 2026 operational costs, possible option to offer carryout from a diverse restaurant or in a specific area that serves minorities.
- New State-wide Data System PeerPlace.
 - AAA Staff is focused on learning and providing training and guidance to Nutrition Site Coordinators and Data Staff to ensure data is accurately reported in the new system.
