## MEDX-1: GPR REDUCTION ACTIONS (\$134,600)

- Reduction in personnel cost
  - Pre-hire funding from 20% to 0%: \$64,600.00
  - Deputy Medical Examiner: \$46,700
- Reduction in operational expenses
  - Transcription services: \$6,000
  - Printing & Office supplies: \$4,200
  - Rental of equipment: \$900
- Offset from cremation permit fees: \$23,300

  - \$27,100

## MEDX-2: PERSONNEL & OPERATIONAL BUDGET LINES (\$106,600)

- LimitedTerm Employment (LTE) Staff
  - Locums MD
- Operational Expenses
  - · Increased supply cost driven by inflation and vendor price adjustments (i.e., body bags, PPE, morgue supplies)
- Final Disposition
  - 2025: 27 unclaimed decedents (80% increase from 2024 to 2025)
    - ~\$600 per decedent
  - 2026: > 30 unclaimed decedents

#### **REVENUE**

- MEDX-4: Revenue increase in paid cremations (\$23,700)\*
  - § 59.36 allows a fee increase based on the increase or decrease in CPI
  - 1.69% CPI (increase of \$6)
- MEDX-5: Revenue increase for Intergovernmental Agreement with Rock

County (\$71,800)\*
