DISABILITY AGING SERVICES

Reduction Details:

Mental Health for Older Adults (\$125,000)

Underutilization of one-on-one mental health services by older adults creating excess capacity in contract

- Crisis Services for Intellectual and/or Developmentally Disabled Adults (\$90,000)
 Need for alternative placement of adults with IDD during periods of dysregulation in a safe-house environment has been greatly reduced over the past 2 years
- Case Management for Older Adults (\$61,585)

Case Management Program for older adults has excess capacity in existing contracts

Volunteer Driver Escorted Transportation (\$42,329)

Reduced interest in persons willing to volunteer to provide private vehicle rides for older adults to medical appointments since COVID, reducing need for mileage reimbursement and recruitment/screening of volunteers
