AUTHORIZING ACCCEPTANCE OF PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON DANE COUNTY ROADMAP TO REDUCING VIOLENCE GRANT FUNDS IN THE CRIME RESPONSE PROGRAM OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE.

The Crime Response Program of the District Attorney's Office was awarded PHMDC Roadmap to Reducing Violence Year Two Grant funding. The \$25,000 in year two grant funding is to be utilized to purchase 25 key fob style panic buttons to be paired with a victim's smartphone. The year one funding purchased the Centurion Elite Emergency Notification System. When activated, Centurion Anywhere will send user's GPS location along with alarm information to Dane County Emergency Dispatch. Funds will be devoted to technology and apparatus to enhance the Centurion system. Additional funds will be utilized for resources to enhance the safety options for victims of crime (phones, cameras, hotel stays).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney's Office, Crime Response Program is hereby authorized to accept \$25,000 of PHMDC grant funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds be channeled through the established accounts in the District Attorney's Crime Response Program (DACRIME) to account for receipt and expenditure of the funds:
