## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County Department of Waste and Renewables and ANEW have agreed that ANEW will waive the contract sone-year Non-Circumvention period beginning on January 1, 2025, and replace it with a one-year service agreement to assist Dane County with preparation for the Biogas Regulatory Reform Regulation (BRRR) and to provide monthly biogas market updates

Current Policy or Practice -

Requires County Board approval

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

If this addendum is not approved, the Agreement with Kwik Trip could not be executed which would result in lost RIN revenue of up to \$10M.

#### Narrative/Assumptions about long range fiscal effect:

This agreement is ultimately replaced with a contract with Kwik Trip where marketing fees are 6% of RIN sales. This contract will cost \$250,000 in 2025 to support a transition from services with ANEW to Kwik Trip. In 2026, the fiscal effect is an annual increase in net revenue of up to \$350,000.
