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AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR COMPETENCY RESTORATION TREATMENT PROVIDED TO DANE COUNTY JAIL RESIDENTS

The State of Wisconsin, Department of Health Services (DHS), requests a contract with Dane County for reimbursement for treatment to competency service, provided by the County, to designated residents in the custody of the Dane County Jail who have been determined by the Court to be not competent to proceed to trail but are likely to become competent if treatment is provided.

The County provides competency restoration treatment, at its own expense, to designated residents, and DHS shall reimburse the County for professional mental health services provided by the County, or its subcontractors, in furtherance of the resident's Courtordered treatment to competency. Services eligible for reimbursement include psychiatric evaluations, medication monitoring, and supportive mental health services including crisis intervention, psychotropic medications. Services shall be provided by qualified professional staff.

DHS reimbursement for competency restoration service as described in the contract shall not exceed \$3,000 per resident. On average, 35 residents per year receive competency restoration treatment potentially providing an estimated \$105,000 annual treatment cost reimbursement to the County. The contract term is November 1, 2023 through October 31, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED a contract is awarded to State of Wisconsin DHS, not to exceed the total amount of \$105,000 annually for reimbursement of Jail resident competency restoration treatment, to begin November 1, 2023, and continue through October 31, 2025; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Dane County Sheriff is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Wisconsin DHS for the above reference competency restoration service reimbursement and that the Dane County Executive and the Dane County Clerk are authorized to execute the contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED a revenue account line is established in Sheriff's Office, Security Services Division, Competency Restoration Treatment Revenue (SHRFSEC NEW) to be credited to the general fund; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that an expenditure account line is created in Sheriff's Office, Security Services Division, Competency Restoration Treatment Expenditures (SHRFSEC NEW) whereby expenditures are authorized to the extent revenues are received and any unexpended funds are carried forward to the next fiscal year.
