Point in Time Count of Homelessness (PIT) Overview

What is Point in Time (PIT)?

- **A snapshot of people experiencing homelessness on a given night**
- Provides the number of individuals and demographic information
- Conducted across the communities in the United States during the last week of January
- Conducted by Madison/Dane County Continuum of Care (CoC) on the fourth Wednesday of January each year
- Used to measure and monitor trends and changes in homelessness on local and national levels

Who are counted in the PIT?

Sheltered Count

- **Emergency shelters** (including those using hotel and motel vouchers)
- **Transitional housing**
- **Safe Havens**

Reports from the shelters and TH

Unsheltered Count

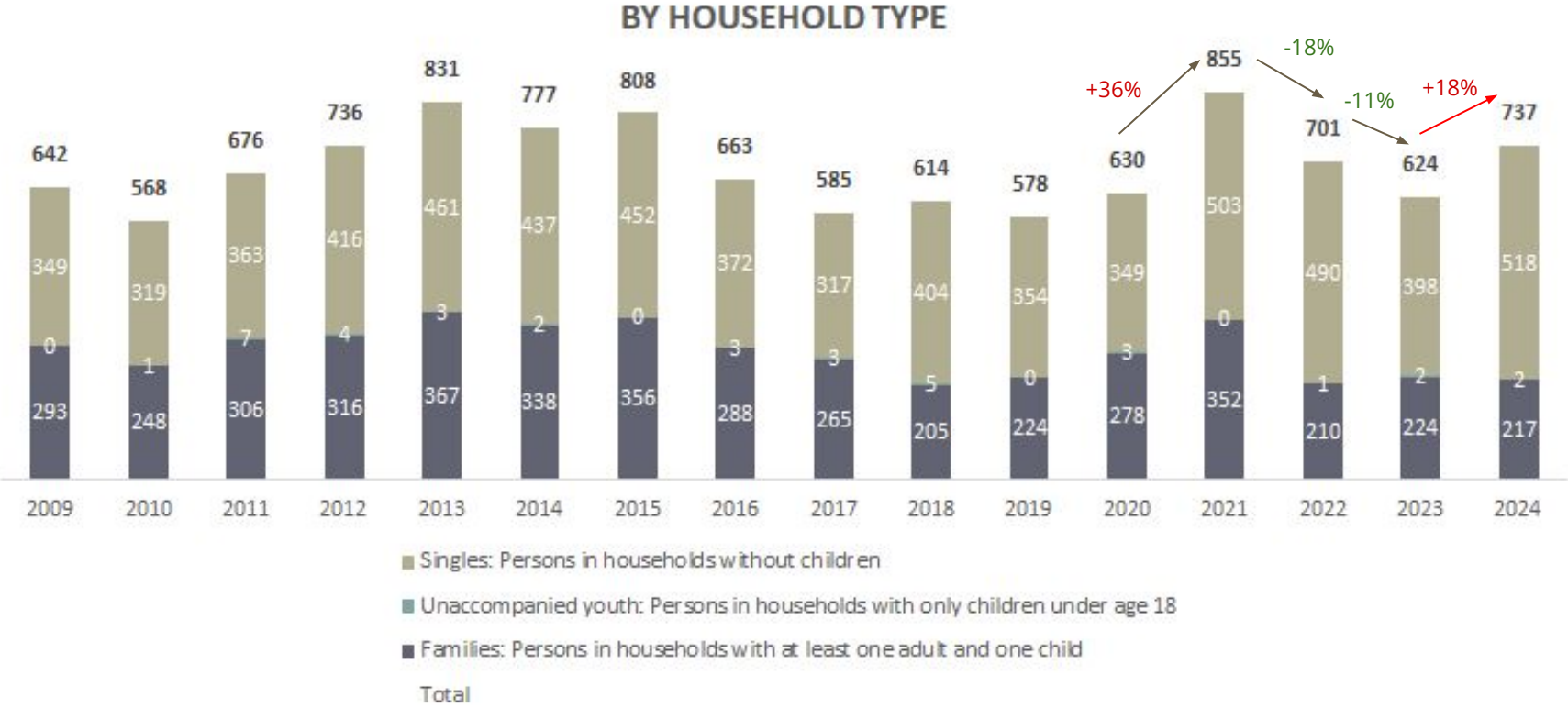
- **Car**
- **Park**
- **Abandoned building**
- **Bus or train station**
- **Airport**
- **Camping ground**
- **Parking Lot**

PIT overnight teams and post count teams

NOTE: PIT does NOT include people experiencing at risk of homelessness, doubled-up homelessness, people on shelter waitlists, or individuals in institutions.

PIT 2009-2024: By Household Type

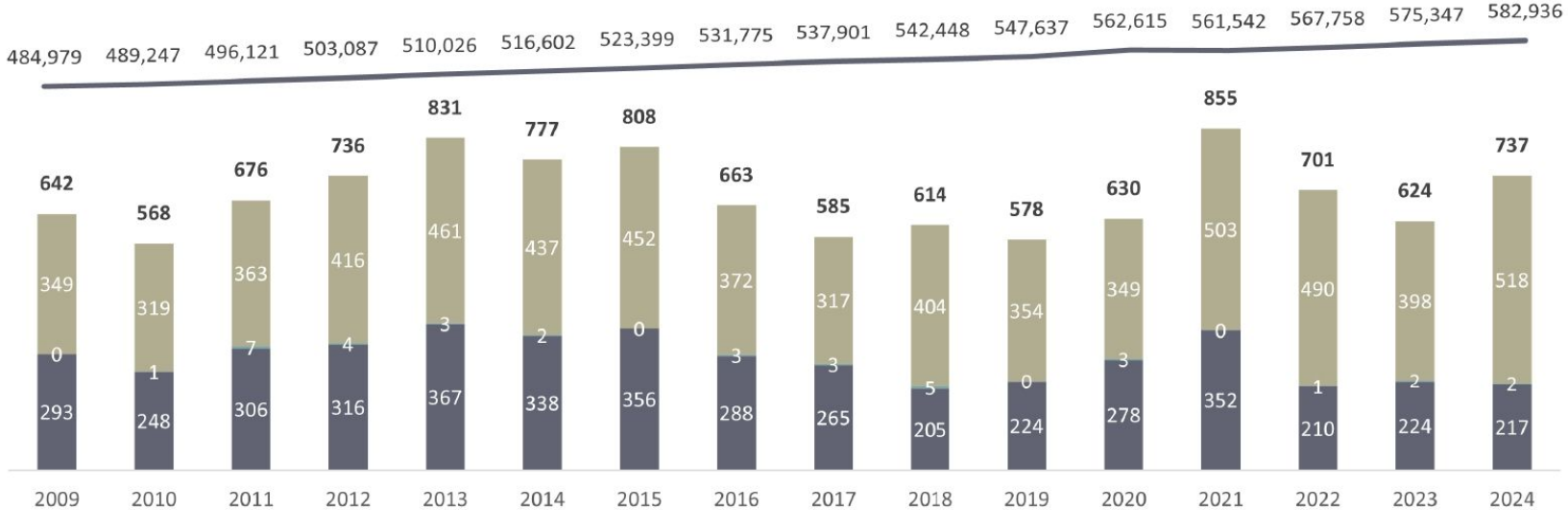

Dane County Population by Household Type

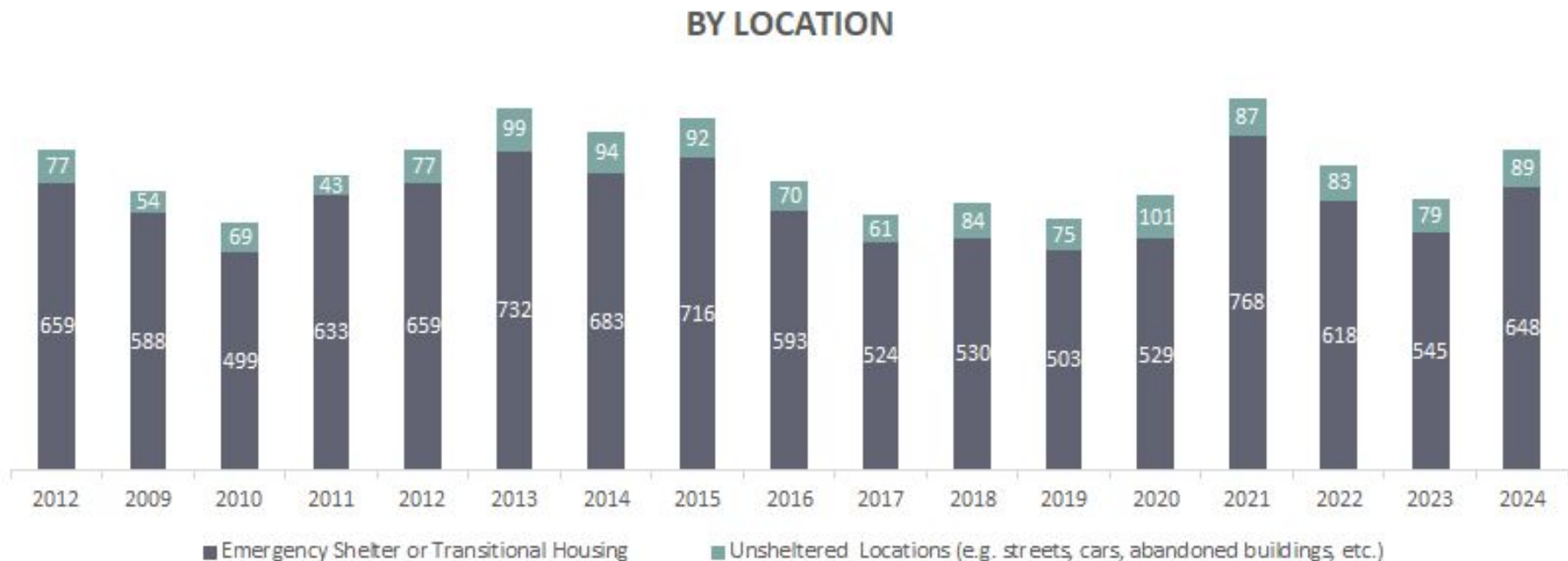

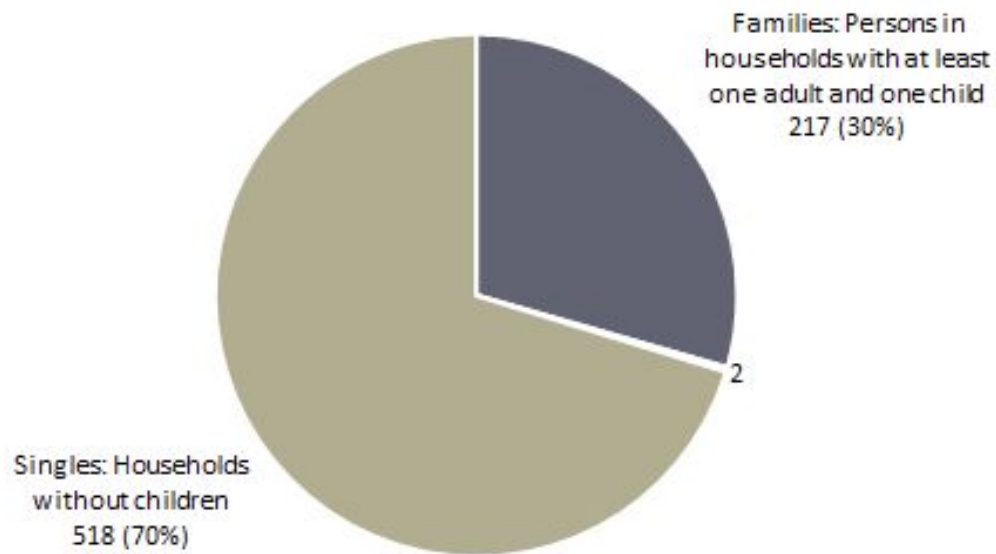

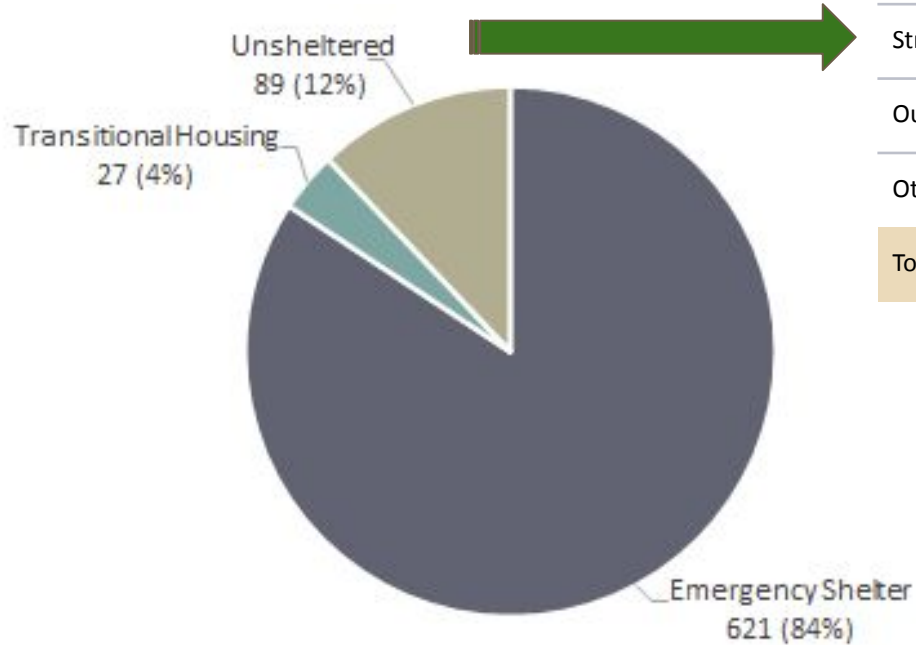

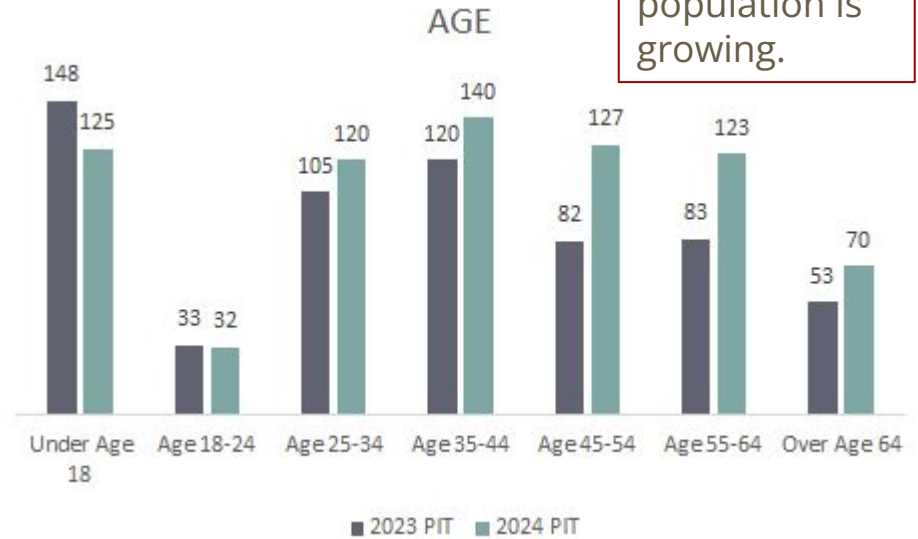
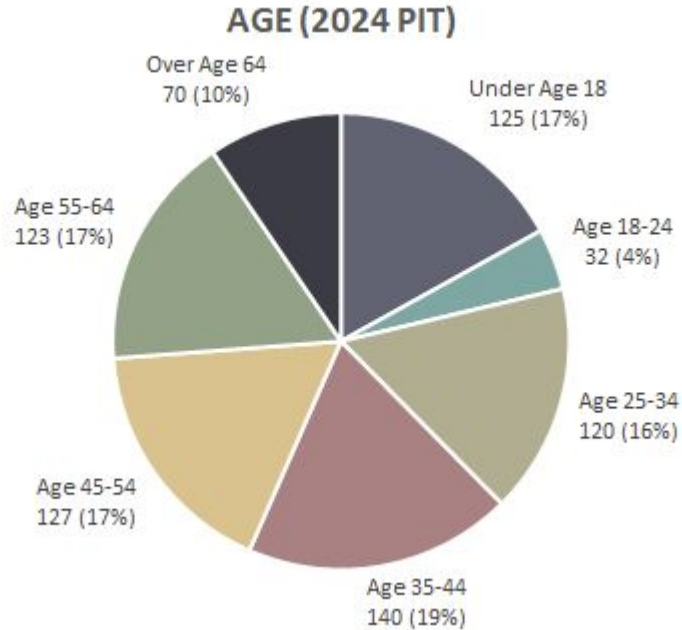

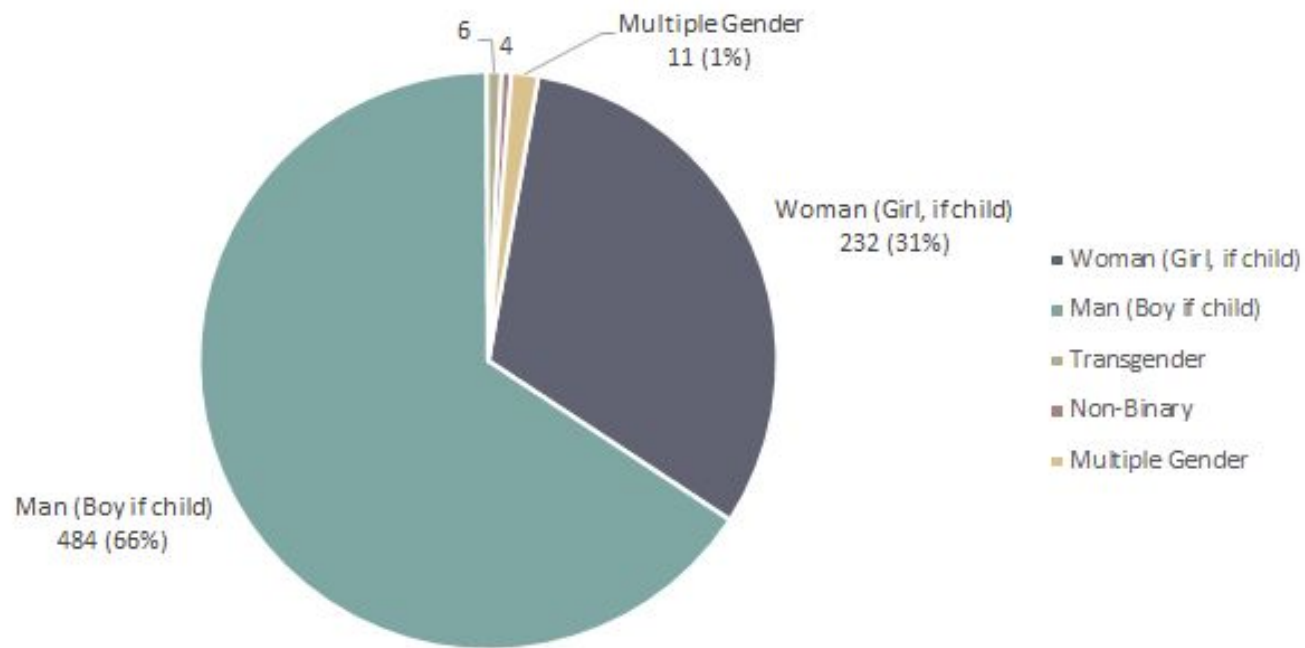
Unsheltered Location	# of Persons	Percentage
