We are looking for a renewal of a five year maintenance agreement. This renewal will ensure that we will continue to receive maintenance, provided by technicians who possess the unique and specific technical qualifications required to service these systems.

The access control and video system installed at the Airport is proprietary and currently maintained by Johnson Controls Inc. (JCI). It is necessary to incorporate the access control and video systems components into a single, fully integrated system for security purposes and efficiency. This requires that the entire system may only be accessed and serviced by Johnson Controls. A proposal for on-going preventive maintenance and planned service is attached. In 2013 the Airport was required to release an RFP for these services to confirm the proprietary nature and sole source requirements for this system. JCI was the only respondent and the system continues to be proprietary and require JCI to perform any work on the system. The Airport requests approval of the bid waiver for this contract. Funds for this work are available in the approved 2023 budget in the AIRADMIN 32329 account.
