



**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING DISAPPROVAL OF A ZONING CODE AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 59.69(5)(e)6. permits a town to disapprove of amendments to county zoning codes when the proposed amendment would affect property located in the town subsequent to their ratification if the amendment differs from the proposed amendment previously sent to the Town; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2023, the Dane County Board adopted an amendment to the Dane County Zoning Code (Sub. 1 2023 OA-09), which allows salvage operations in the MI-Industrial District as conditional uses; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has considered the amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board previously disapproved of the petition filed for enactment of the amendment;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MIDDLETON, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town Board of the Town of Middleton County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, confirms its disapproval of Sub. 1 2023 OA-09, a copy of which is attached to this resolution, relating to allowing salvage operations in the MI-Manufacturing and Industrial District as a conditional use.
