AWARDING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT TO THE DANE COUNTY
DEPUTY SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION

The County has reached a tentative agreement with the Dane County Deputy Sheriffs' Association on a successor agreement that will run from December 17, 2023 through December 15, 2024. The current agreement expires on December 16, 2023. The County employs approximately 400 full time equivalent employees in this bargaining unit.

The agreed upon principle economic items include increases to the wages, increase of undesirable hours pay, increase of training officer compensatory time and pay for working in the Bailiff's office, increase in pay for supplemental assignments, increase in floating holiday hours, increase in money for new employee uniforms, increases in maximum amount for the sick bank, increase in bereavement leave hours, stillbirth policy, and an increase of retirement enhancement money. The economic items agreed to are within the County's budgetary constraints. All negotiated changes are highlighted in the attached summary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors approves the terms and conditions of a successor agreement between Dane County and the Dane County Deputy Sheriff's Association for the period of December 17, 2023 through December 15, 2024, with the attached negotiated changes; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that County officials take appropriate action to implement this resolution.
