Intent/Justification			
The 2024 budget included funding for a contract with the UW-Madison Department of Landscape Architecture and Planning for a planning assistant to work with county committees, the Dane County Historical Society, and the community to identify and prioritize potential sites for historical markers specifically recognizing Dane County's culturally diverse history. That work produced a robust and growing list of potential marker sites. \$10,000 will cover the materials and labor to install about three markers at an estimated \$3,400 per marker. This proposal provides flexibility to cover possible related costs.
