AMENDING CHAPTER 46 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES - REGARDING PRIVATE ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS (POWTS)

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Due to changes in the Wisconsin State Statutes and Administrative Rules regarding private onsite wastewater treatment systems, Public Health Madison & Dane County is recommending Dane County Ordinance Chapter 46 be updated and amended accordingly.

The current Dane County Ordinance Chapter 46 is out of date and not aligned with current definitions and codes in Wisconsin State Statutes and Administrative Rules.
