**AUTHORIZING RECLASSIFICATION OF VACANT POSITION
DCDHS – BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DIVISION**

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -
This resolution authorizes the reclassification of the Behavioral Health Resource Specialist position in the Human Services Department to a Case Manager position.

Current Policy or Practice -
Changes in position reclassification require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -
The Case Manager classification is more suited to the work that this position will need to perform, including providing relevant and accurate information on behavioral health services to members of the public, working closely with providers that are available to provide behavioral health services, follow-up with members of the public to ensure referrals have met individuals' needs, among other duties.
