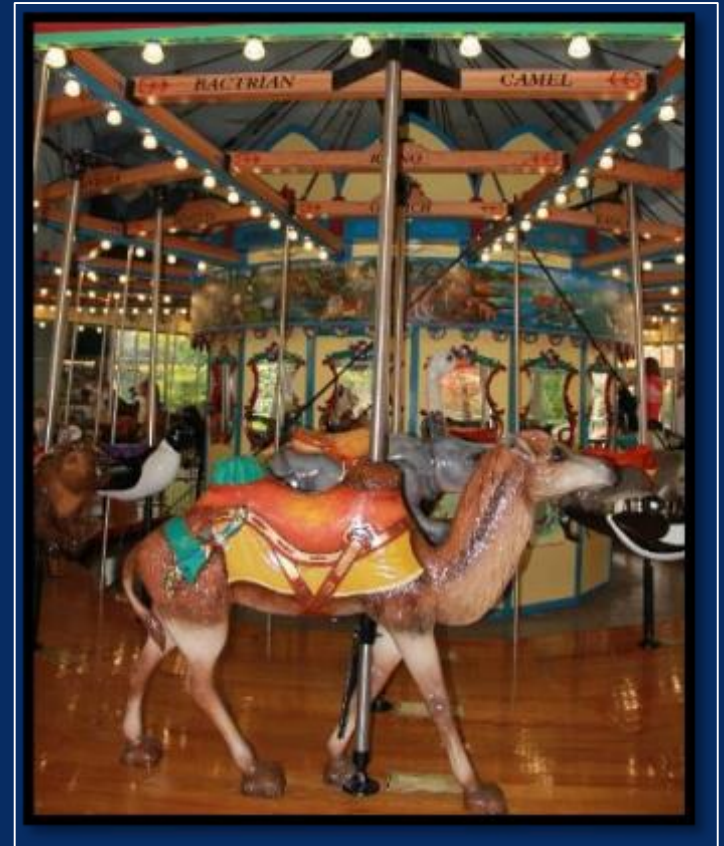

- CONTRACTUAL CHANGES– *None*
- REALLOCATIONS – *None*
- COST REDUCTION –
 - Elimination of vacant positions
 - 1.0 Education Coordinator and 0.5 Clerk I-II.
 - Cost savings of \$165,400
 - Line item reductions in operations.
 - Cost savings of \$12,500
 - Line item reductions in contractual expenses
 - Cost savings of \$5,525
- TOTAL COST REDUCTION = \$183,425

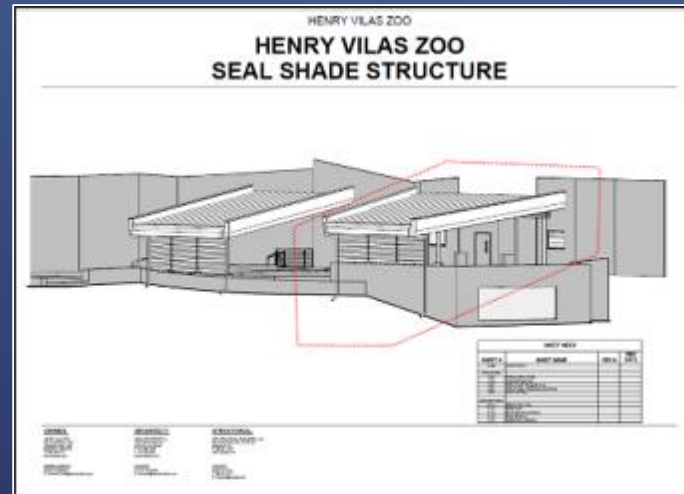

HENRY VILAS ZOO HIGHLIGHTS

► Education:

- Waste and Renewables Dept/Purple Cow Organics
 - Zoo sends 2 tons of manure per week to be composted
 - Return to the zoo to the grounds and gardens
 - Pilot program food scrap drop off kiosk
 - Four kiosks around Madison, the zoo site is the most used, collecting ~ 4,500 pounds of food waste in the first two months.
- Kenya Ol Jogi Wildlife Ranger Wildlife Pushup Challenge
- Center for Climatic Research at UW-Madison
 - Zoo Explorers Sensory Friendly Camp – 2nd year

But we need your help with the last stretch of funding!

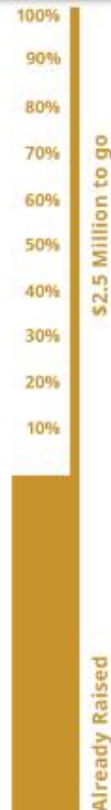
We've already secured the lion's share of what we need (over \$19 million, thank you so much to previous donors!), but we need a bit more to reach our goals.
