3	AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE WISCONSIN
4	DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S BYRNE STATEWIDE CRISIS INTERVENTION PROGRAM

7	The Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement Services has approved a grant award
8	to Dane County through the Byrne Statewide Crisis Intervention Programs (SCIP), Bureau of Justice
9	Assistance. Funds will be utilized in a joint collaboration between the Dane County District Attorney's
10	Office, Focused Interruption (a community based nonprofit organization supporting victims of gun
11	violence), and Public Health Madison Dane County's Violence Intervention Team. The goal is to provide
12	direct services to gun violence victims and implement gun violence prevention strategies centered on
13	community outreach and engagement. This includes, for example; emergency relocation, mental health
14	services and emergency lodging. See Grant Number: 2023-SCI-01-19680. Funding is available 1/1/2026
15	through 9/30/2026 in the sum of \$100,000 for Dane County's District Attorney Crime Response Program
16	(DACRIME).

18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that District Attorney's Crime Response Program
19	is hereby authorized to accept the Byrne Statewide Crisis Intervention Programs (SCIP), Bureau of
20	Justice Assistance grant, administered by the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice, in the amount
21	of \$100,000; and

23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following accounts be established in the District
24	Attorney's Office Crime Response Program (DACRIME) to account for receipt and expenditure of the
25	funds. The following line adjustments are made to the 2026 budget for the District Attorney's Office:

28	DACRIME NEW BYNE SCIP GRANT EXPENSE \$100,000

BE IT RESOLVED that the unspent expenditures & unrecognized revenue from this grant program are carried forward until fully utilized.
