RESOLUTION 2025 RES-20

**AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT
OF HEALTH SERVICES (DHS) FOR COMMERCIAL TOBACCO PREVENTION AND
TREATMENT PROGRAM (CTPTP) COMMUNITY INTERVENTIONS AND WI WINS**

Public Health Madison & Dane County (Public Health) proposes the acceptance of additional \$9,847.00 from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) for Commercial Tobacco Prevention and Treatment Program (CTPTP) Community Interventions and WI WINS.

The Board of Health for Madison and Dane County previously approved Resolution 2024-38 authorizing the acceptance of \$140,712.00 from DHS for Tobacco Prevention and Control (Community Interventions) (\$121,000.00) and Tobacco Prevention and Control (WI WINS) (\$19,712.00). Public Health received an additional \$9,847.00 from DHS, increasing the total amount to \$150,559.

Funds from DHS will support strategies to prevent the use of commercial tobacco and enforce tobacco retailer compliance with existing laws and policies for product sales.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County on behalf of Public Health Madison & Dane County authorizes the Director of Public Health, or their designee, to sign the agreement, accept and expend the funding, and amend the 2025 Public Health Budget by \$9,847.00.
