Hello Zoning & Land Regulation Committee Members:

I would like to register my opposition to the Conditional Use Permit application at 3440 Meadow Rd. I am a nearby Town of Middleton resident & am concerned that granting the CUP, will result in decreased quality of life & decreased property values in the Township due to barking dogs & greatly increased vehicular traffic in this growing residential area. In addition, increased public safety responses & requests for service are also possible, due to noise complaints, vehicle crashes, & at-large animal complaints.

I am also concerned & opposed to possible un-checked expansion of this business, such as "RV Parking, Outdoor Storage, Community Gardening Plots, & Pickleball Courts" that have been previously proposed on the La Fleur Stables website: https://lstables.com/

Regarding the sound studies conducted, these appear to be objective electronic sound level measurements & do not measure subjective, human response & sensitivity to the sound. For example, a professional dog handler may have a largely positive or neutral response to barking dogs, on one end of the spectrum. On the other end, a person previously having one or more negative dog encounters, may have an extreme negative response to barking dogs sound. The studies mention noise, in addition to sound level. I would ask that you recognize the difference.

Perhaps a business of this nature would be better located in an existing Township commercial zoned area with lower residential density, such as the Hwy 14/Twin Valley Rd or Seybold Rd/Watts Rd areas, for example, that are just minutes away from the proposed CUP location. The CUP proposal does not seem to meet ALL the CUP standards required.
