



Department Overview



Our department aims to reduce pretrial detention by providing pretrial support and bail monitoring to eligible defendants in the Dane County Criminal Courts.

Budget Details

- Reduce Drug Testing by \$11,000 fund supplies only and eliminate confirmation tests
- Reduce Peer Support by \$19,500 reduce peer support and wrap up contracted services
- Reduce Electronic Monitoring by \$26,500 negotiating reduced pricing and discussing programmatic changes with judiciary to accommodate cuts
- Reduce Printing/Office Supplies by \$972
- Increase Software Subscriptions by \$1,000 Increased expenditure is covered by additional \$1000 reduction

Impacts and Considerations

- ▶ We will need to reduce EM usage by about 30-40% in 2026.
- Judges use electronic monitoring as an alternative to incarceration, so reduced usage may impact the jail population, but we are evaluating programmatic changes in an effort to address this.
- The judiciary, Pretrial Services, and District Attorney's Office have discussed the need for 24/7 monitoring of GPS violations to protect victim rights, but this would require additional funding.
