1 Esri Licensing Update

Watson reported to the council that in 2026 Esri will migrate all user based products to subscription model. Concurrent licensing will no longer be available. This will result in a significant cost increase to maintain the Esri licensing and that the LIO would not be able to cover. Some options would be to pursue an Enterprise Agreement and look at a Capital expenditure or start to bill department for the cost. The LIO will be working with administration and departments to plan for this change.

2 Update on 3DEP WLIP project

lausly reported that the county is going through the approval process for a contract with the state and USGS for a 3DEP project to acquire updated LiDAR data. This project provided funding for about 60 percent of the funding. The USGS base products will be available in a year and additional funding will be needed to develop the enhanced terrain data products.

3 Land Information Plan update.

lausly reported that work has started on updating the LIO Plan, as required by the state. He shared some highlights and encourage council members to review the current plan that is available on the LIO homepage, https://lio.danecounty.gov/, and provide comments. He will be working with various departments on sections of the plan.
