Add the following language to 2025 RES-174: "Pursuant to Wis. Stat. 59.54(16), receipt of revenue from the housing of federal prisoners, Federal Residents in Transit, shall not be authorized unless an agreement with the United States Marshall Service has been approved in advance by the County Board. Prior to pursuing a contract for the housing of federal prisoners, the Dane County Board of Supervisors hereby requests that the Department of Administration and Division of Facilities Management perform a cost analysis for boarding the projected number of Federal Residents in Transit to determine an appropriate daily rate that reflects the actual cost of housing such individuals in the Dane County Jail. Findings of the analysis shall be presented to the Dane County Sheriff's Office and the Public Protection & Judiciary Committee. Any proposed contract for housing federal prisoners should include the rate resulting from the analysis, reflecting the actual cost of housing such individuals in the Dane County Jail.

The Dane County Board of Supervisors hereby requests that the U.S. Marshall Service provide justification to DCSO for each Federal Resident in Transit's housing status in the Dane County Jail, and that Federal Residents in Transit are only housed in the Dane County Jail if they have a pending hearing in Dane County and/or personal connection to Dane County such as former residence or strong social connections. The Dane County Board of Supervisors further asserts that Dane County residents be housed in the Dane County jail and receive priority housing over any Federal Residents in Transit.

The Dane County Board of Supervisors hereby requests that DCSO present findings to the Public Protection & Judiciary Committee by August 2026 with an analysis of jail residents transported outside of Dane County and any changes in volume of transports relative to housing Federal Residents in Transit. The Dane County Board acknowledges and appreciates that daily jail census data continues to include details regarding transports and

Intent/Justification

The 2026 Operating Budget includes \$1.559 million in revenue for housing Federal residents. This amendment clarifies that such revenue is not authorized unless the County Board has approved a contract agreement with the United States Marshall Service and requests that such a contract include a daily rate that reflects actual costs determined by a cost analysis to ensure that Dane County tax payers are not subsidizing the cost of housing people in the federal correctional system.

Intent/Justification Dane County purchases most of the human services delivered to county residents from POS agencies. The allowable administrative cost rate varies depending on each contract but costs are never allowed to exceed 15%. POS agencies have expressed concern that their contracted administrative cost rates are too low. While there is a procedure for obtaining an administrative rate contract variance, the county rarely—if ever—approves a variance. County POS agencies continue to face a number of challenges to the viability of their work related to increasingly complex client needs, state and federal funding cuts, proposed county funding cuts, health insurance cost increases, and recruitment and retention of staff. Meeting these challenges involves additional administrative time. This amendment would require all 2026 human services program funding contracts to include an administrative cost ceiling of 15% unless such a ceiling is prohibited by law or other contract because of the particular type of funding the county is administering for that POS contract.

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Intent/Justification This amendment provides \$440,000 \$600,000 in funding for outreach and potential overflow shelter operations needed to serve unhoused and unsheltered households without children due to the expected opening of the new purpose-built shelter at Bartillion Drive which has a capacity limit of 250 shelter guests. The number of households without children has significantly increased and if the Zeier Road temporary shelter operation ends when the new shelter opens, approximately 150-200 households without children will be experiencing unsheltered homelessness.
